### What is the P.U.L.L. Campaign?

Arts Holding Hands and Hearts, Inc. (AHHAH) spearheaded a grass roots campaign to put 100 lending libraries, called P.U.L.L. Stations, throughout Coatesville where children gather.

### “Take a Book, Read a Book, Leave a Book”

We encourage people to **TAKE** the books from the P.U.L.L. stations to **READ** to children and then **LEAVE** books for others to read.

### Why Do We Need P.U.L.L.?

A child's ability to read impacts their ability to succeed. Reading below grade level increases their chances of dropping out of school and being incarcerated. Many of our children are not being exposed to enough words and reading before age 5. As a result,
